The following water wells are exempt from obtaining operating permits but must be registered under current District rules as stipulated in a Landscape Irrigation Water Well Variance for Hilltop Lakes agreement. This agreement was approved by the District, the Property Owner's Association of Hilltop Lakes, Inc., (POA), and the Hilltop Lakes Water Supply Corporation (WSC). A copy of this agreement may be obtained from either the POA, WSC or the District.

1. Application for drilling a landscape irrigation water well shall be forwarded to the District by the Architectural Control Committee (ACC) with its request for approval. Once approved by the District, the ACC along with the property owner will be notified and drilling may commence.
2. The minimum property line setback (spacing) must be 15 feet from the nearest property line. The centerline of a public roadway is permissible to calculate this setback.
3. A well log and Driller's Completion Report must be filed with the District not later than 60 days after well completion. Well construction and completion must meet Texas Department of Licensing and Regulation (TDLR) standards as stipulated in *Texas Occupation Code*, Chapters 1901 and 1902.
4. The location of the water well must adhere to regulations set forth in *Texas Administrative Code* Section 76.100 pertaining to the sitting of well from a septic system.
5. The water well must be pressure cemented or grouted to 100 feet or pressure cemented or grouted to the water table if the water table is less than 100 feet.
6. These wells are to be used for home landscape irrigation only and no connection is to be made to any residence or other building where domestic use may be involved.
7. The maximum production rate from such wells is limited to 12 gallons per minute.
8. The depth of such wells is limited to not more than 200 feet.
9. The General Manager for the District is authorized to approve registrations that meet the above conditions. Water wells that do not meet the above qualifications must be permitted with the District.

Once the water well is completed, the owner shall contact the District to facilitate an inspection of the water well to ensure that the well is completed as stipulated herein. Failure to meet all requirements as stipulated in this application may result in penalties subject to Rule 15 of the District Rules.

By signing this application, the applicant hereby agrees with the rules of the Mid-East Texas Groundwater Conservation District and the requirements as stipulated in the Landscape Irrigation Water Well Variance for Hilltop Lakes agreement.
