 - Well #2, CR 355 Oakwood TX; Latitude 31.5606 North, Longitude -95.9515 West at a proposed depth of approximately 600 feet to produce groundwater from the Carrizo Aquifer.
 - Well #3, CR 355 Oakwood TX; Latitude 31.5641 North, Longitude -95.9524 West at a proposed depth of approximately 600 feet to produce groundwater from the Carrizo Aquifer.
