Proposed Desired Future Conditions for Area Aquifers

The Mid-East Texas Groundwater Conservation District is currently receiving public comments on the proposed desired future conditions for the area aquifers that were recently adopted by Groundwater Management Area 12 under §36.108, Texas Water Code. Groundwater Management Area 12 includes the following groundwater conservation districts: Mid-East Texas Groundwater Conservation District (GCD), Brazos Valley GCD, Post Oak Savannah GCD, Lost Pines GCD, and Fayette County GCD. The District will hold a public hearing on the proposed desired future conditions at a time to be determined in the future.
