

**Mid-East Texas GCD's Notice of Public Comment Period for  
the Proposed Desired Future Conditions of the Aquifers by Groundwater  
Management Area 12 (GMA 12)**

The Mid-East Texas Groundwater Conservation District (METGCD) is currently receiving public comments on proposed desired future conditions (DFCs) for the relevant aquifers in Madison, Leon, and Freestone counties through 2080 until August 31, 2026, pursuant to §36.108, *Texas Water Code*. The Texas Water Development Board (TWDB) designated Groundwater Management Area 12 (GMA 12) to include: METGCD, Brazos Valley GCD, Lost Pines GCD, Post Oak Savannah GCD, and Fayette County GCD. The following DFCs values are expressed in average water level drawdown across METGCD from 2011 through 2079: **Yegua-Jackson Aquifer:** 9 feet; **Sparta Aquifer:** 22 feet; **Queen City Aquifer:** 19 feet; **Carrizo Aquifer:** 48 feet; **Calvert Bluff Aquifer:** 58 feet; **Simsboro Aquifer:** 85 feet; **Hooper Aquifer:** 74 feet.
