

Amended Operating Permit
Issued by Direction of the
Mid-East Texas Groundwater Conservation District

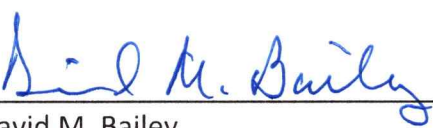
This **Operating Permit** is granted to **Wayne-Sanderson Farms LLC** (Permittee) authorizing Permittee to operate water well known as **Feed Mill Well** ("Well") at the location specified below within the Mid-East Texas Groundwater Conservation District (District) for the beneficial purpose of producing water for **Commercial/Public Water Supply Use**. The validity of this permit to operate the Well is contingent upon and subject to the Permittee complying with the Rules of the District ("Rules"), orders of the Board and the Management Plan of the District, as amended, and the laws, rules and regulations of the State of Texas, as amended, applicable pursuant to Chapter 8866, *Special District Local Laws Code* and Chapter 36, *Water Code*.

The well is located at **31.601155° N** and **-95.831446° W** and is to produce water from the **Carrizo Aquifer** at a depth of **360 feet** with a maximum capacity not to exceed **200 GPM**. The well is located northeast of Oakwood Texas in **Freestone County**. The amount of water to be withdrawn on an annual basis may not exceed **20,072,422 gallons** or **61.6 acre-feet** per year. Water production is limited to the on-site facility; no groundwater is to be transported off site.

The operation of the well for the authorized withdrawal must be conducted in a non-wasteful manner. Withdrawals must be metered by the owner using a device or an approved method that is within plus or minus 5% of accuracy. An annual water use report shall be submitted as required by District Rule 3.2. The well site must be accessible to District representatives for inspection, and the permittee agrees to cooperate fully in any reasonable inspection of the well and well site by the District Representative, conducted according to District Rule 15.6. If the well is plugged, the Permittee will use reasonable diligence to protect groundwater quality and will follow well plugging regulations in place at the time of the well closure.

The application pursuant to which this permit has been issued is incorporated in this permit, and this permit is granted on the basis of and contingent upon the accuracy of the information supplied in that application. A finding that false information has been supplied is grounds for immediate revocation of the permit. Violation of the permit's terms, conditions, requirements, or special provisions, including pumping amounts in excess of authorized withdrawals may subject the permittee to an enforcement action under District Rule 15. **The term of this permit is five (5) years from the date it was approved by the district.**

This permit is issued and effective as of August 20, 2023. *Permit expires on August 20, 2028.*
Permit amended June 19, 2026 in order to increase annual production by 10%.
